




Dear Readers, Greetings to you!!

NAAN MUDHALVAN UPSKILLING PLATFORM | 2023









- Our college is the ground partner of Coal India 2023. A state level football tournament participated in registration forum at MCC hr. sec school Chetpet on 26th Jan 2023.


